The Company has been closely monitoring COVID-19 with the local government. Our hotels are working to ensure that they meet the latest guidance on hygiene and cleaning. Our hotels' health and safety measures are designed to address a broad spectrum of viruses, including COVID-19, and includes everything from handwashing hygiene and cleaning product specifications to guest room and common area cleaning procedures.

To ensure strict standards of cleanliness and mitigate the impact of COVID-19 Pandemic, this new scheme will evaluate the efficacy of cleaning and disinfection procedures in each resort. The products, protocols and measures are therefore certified and audited by SGS.

This scheme consists of a sanitary and hygiene inspection coupled with onsite testing using the latest technology ATP (Adenosine – Triphosphate) or RT qPCR with results available within 3 hours after sample collection.
